3	<p>Declaration of Interest.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> EJ and AD declared an interest in the Llangefni Cycle Friendly Town and Anglesey Bird Cycle Routes RCDF applications submitted by IACC and left the room whilst that item was discussed. MF declared that she was a member of the food group Gorau Môn but had not been party to the preparation of the proposal. It was decided that would not affect her ability to take part in discussions on the proposal. 	
4	<p>Minutes of Meeting – 07/12/15 The minutes of the meeting were accepted as being correct. Proposed by : Dewi Jones, Seconded by : Mark Gahan</p>	
5	<p>Matters Arising 2.3 No nominations for Vice Chair had been received 2.8 This matter was included on the agenda. 2.10 Few responses on time of meetings had been received. Late afternoon seemed to be fairly convenient and it was agreed to aim for a start time of 3:30</p>	
6	<p>Changes to the Control Plan EJ outlined the reasons for reviewing the Control Plan noting that in addition to it being a Welsh Government stipulation, the Control Plan needed to be revised to reflect the Thematic Groups’ involvement in shaping project proposals for approval by the Partnership. DG went on to explain the flow diagrams in more detail.</p> <p>The proposed changes to the Control Plan were agreed.</p>	
7	<p>Membership Review It is a Welsh Government stipulation that Partnership membership be reviewed annually. To help ensure a quorum at meetings, it was proposed that Partnership membership be increased to 21 – i.e. seven from each sector, but that the voting cohort remains at 18. Additional members would be recruited by means of an advert in the press. It was suggested that the advert asked for specialisation / interest in digital technology.</p> <p>The proposal to increase Partnership numbers to 21 was agreed</p>	<p>Advert to be placed in the local press to recruit additional members.</p>
8	<p>Rural Community Development Fund Applications The Partnership had been requested to review the applications and comment on whether or not they fitted with the approved Local Development Strategy. Llangefni Cycle Friendly Town – YES – Could be extended to other areas. Anglesey Bird Cycle Routes – YES – Anglesey Show – YES – No Comment</p>	
9	<p>Welsh Government Role John Davies explained that Community Led Local Development within the Rural Development Plan involved LEADER, FLAG (Fisheries), Co – Operation and the Rural Community Development Fund.</p>	

	<p>His responsibilities involve supporting the 18 Local Action Groups with e.g. compliance with their Terms of Reference, control plans and Local Delivery Strategies.</p> <p>He would try and attend as many LAG meetings as possible and share good practice. With the LAG's permission, he wished to share the template to record Declarations of Interests with other partnerships.</p> <p>He mentioned the launch of the RDP in Swansea the previous month noting that windows for submitting Eols under 5 RDP schemes had already opened and a further one would open in March. 10	<p>Project Proposals</p> <p>g) <u>5k Funding for specialist support for project development</u>. This proposal had been discussed at the previous LAG meeting, but had not been decided upon. It was noted that this was effectively a £25,000 project (5 themes @ £5K)</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p> <p>h) <u>MônSAR</u> – a proposal to trial a lowland search and rescue service on Anglesey to be involved in the search for vulnerable people e.g. those with Alzheimer's or mental health issues.</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p> <p>i) <u>Branding and marketing the food group</u> - to look at strengthening the brand for Anglesey food.</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p> <p>j) <u>Cynefin</u> – A proposal to develop a variation of Energy Local aiming to address fuel poverty, and reduce CO2 in off gas homes in south west Anglesey.</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p> <p>k) <u>Age Well</u> – A proposal developed with Age Well and other stakeholders to trial the engagement of housebound people over 50 to embrace the use of digital technology for e.g online shopping / skypeing etc.</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p> <p>Co-operation Project</p> <p>l) <u>Shinagh Farm Visit</u> – a project for young dairy farmers to visit a research farm looking at the New Zealand system of Dairy production. Because the farm was located in Southern Ireland it could not be funded by other aspects of the RDP. It would involve one participant from Anglesey.</p> <p>It was resolved that the proposal be supported.</p>
